
Expanding..Growing..Reaching..

Prison Fellowship Malawi

CFA has partnered with Prison Fellowship Malawi to support its work in prison evangelism, prisoner rehabilitation programs, and job training programs to help former prisoners transition back into a healthy lifestyle. Because Prison Fellowship Malawi has to raise its own funds to support the halfway house and all of its programming, CFA has helped support income-generating projects that PF Malawi can use to fund these programs.

- **\$400** will support **one** resident in the 6 month halfway house. That includes job training and a take home set of tools as they re-enter society.

Rural Churches

CFA has partnered with Pastor Moses of Word of Grace Church to reach some of the most rural areas of Malawi with the word of Christ. Pastor Moses oversees a number of church plants and partners with pastors for training. Please keep these pastors and churches in your prayers.

Rural Schools

CFA supports two nursery schools and one primary school, all of which are run by Word of Grace Church. Each school uses a Christian curriculum to reach out to communities that may not otherwise offer schooling. These three schools offer education to over 300 students each year! The village chiefs have expressed appreciation that their communities are getting a good education and the children are gaining knowledge and nourishment from the education and meals that these schools provide.

Current Needs: (in addition to meals and salaries)

- We are building a Nursery School in Mvera to meet government standards. We have raised \$1500 dollars and are still in need of **\$2400** to finish this project. It will serve the needs of over 100 nursery school children.
- A well is needed at Word of Grace Church in Bimbi. This will serve the needs of the Nursery School, Church and frequent pastoral training. The village women who now walk 2 km to get their water will also be allowed to draw water from this well near the Church. What a blessing that will be to them! The well is estimated to cost **\$5000**.

CFA works in many areas of Malawi that are extremely rural and receive little outside support. Many of the pastors in these churches have little to no formal Bible education or spiritual leadership training, yet they are passionate about their work and hungry to learn more. Over the last few years, CFA has partnered with other ministries such as Exodus Vision to bring training to these rural pastors through pastoral conferences and Bible study resources. Many of the pastors who attend these conferences walk, bike, or bus to the conference from miles away, some coming as far as Mozambique.
