Schools

Bimbi and Mvera Schools continue to serve over 300 children. Praise God for the relationship Pastor Moses has with the leaders who have welcomed CFA's Christian based school into their mainly Muslim area.

Pray for these children from mainly Muslim families.

Bimbi Irrigation Project

Pray for this 35 hectare solar powered irrigation project near Liwonde National Park in Malawi. When completed it will bless 300-400 families from 5 communities that struggle with salty well water. Phase 1 with its 3 year trial period is over and we are delighted that plans are underway to begin phase 2 which will bring water from the Shire River.
