You can invest in the Christian education of many children in Mvera, Malawi!

In June a school building in Zomba, Malawi collapsed killing four children and injuring others. This has led the government to inspect all schools for needed repair or replacement.

One of the school buildings we support in Mvera was condemned. This is a school that CFA did not build, but we support the teaching that happens in it. There are currently 220 children that attend school here, receiving a Christian education and a meal each day. For the time being school will have to be held outside, but the rainy season is coming soon!

An extra room will be added to the school to accommodate a lodging area for the teacher and his family. Because of the remote location of this community the teacher must ride his bike for 2 hours to get to the school and again at the end of the day to get home. We had planned on fundraising to build a house on the school site, now we will include it in the new school. We are excited about the opportunity to combine these two needs into one and save money in the process!

A well is needed at this school site also. We have been raising funds for this and have about half of the money needed. If we can raise enough funds we will also put the well in. It is a 2 km walk to get water!

Funds needed for new Primary School - \$10,850.
Funds still needed for the well - \$4000.

Prison Fellowship Malawi

Prison Fellowship Malawi received a European Union grant last year, and we continue to assist in helping to build the general fund to supplement this grant. We support the areas that provide income ~ the livestock and garden program as well as the Deli operation in town.

The Halfway House is fully operational with 60 residents at a time who benefit from job skills training, mentoring and spiritual guidance. Vocational Skills Training is offered for Tailoring, Electrical, Carpentry and Welding. After graduation a new group of residents will arrive. The goal is to train 300 prisoners or ex-prisoners over a 3 year period. As each resident graduates they are provided with a tool kit in their area of training to take home and start a business in their own communities. Each kit is \$400, and they are not covered with the grant money. Will you sponsor a resident?

Pastor Training

CFA works in many areas of Malawi that are extremely rural and receive little outside support. Many of the pastors in these churches have little to no formal bible education or spiritual leadership training, yet they are passionate about their work and hungry to learn more. Training Leaders International has decided to extend a 3 year Basic Seminary Training for these pastors!

A 12 capacity guesthouse was built this summer and the first training session with 40 Rural Church Leaders is happening in October! Praise God for His faithfulness!



85 Acre Irrigation Project

This is a project that has been in the works for over two years. It is up and running with 6 acres being worked now. People have been trained in gardening and business and are hoping for a December harvest. 30 families are in this initial group, many of which are part of the Word of Grace Church family! If all goes well up to 400 families will eventually have garden plots!



Rural Schools

CFA supports two nursery schools and one primary school, all of which are run by Word of Grace Church. Each school uses a Christian curriculum to reach out to communities that may not otherwise offer schooling. These three schools offer education to over 550 students each year! The village chiefs have expressed appreciation that their communities are getting a good education and the children are gaining knowledge and nourishment from the education and meals that these schools provide.

Current Needs: (in addition to meals and salaries)

- We are building a Primary School in Mvera to meet government standards. We need to raise \$10,850 for this project. It will serve the needs of over 220 school children.
- A well is needed at Mvera. This will serve the needs of the school and community. The school cooks now walk 2 km to get their water. What a blessing that will be to them! We still need an additional \$4000 of the estimated \$8000.
